Conservation camp was developed to aid Scouts in earning the William T. Hornaday Award. During this week, you will focus on earning the merit badges necessary to complete the award. You will also be coached through the process of selecting and carrying out a project for your award. You will get to select from the Merit Badges listed below. The requirements for each Hornaday Award are listed at the bottom of this page. Scouts will also participate in a conservation project, allowing them to earn the SOAR award and the World Conservation Award.

- FOR THE HORNADAY BADGE**, Scouts earn three of the merit badges listed above in the primary group, plus any two others. (The merit badges with the line strikethrough are not offered at BDSR.) Then plan, lead, and carry out a significant project in natural resource conservation, from one of the project categories listed.
- FOR THE HORNADAY BRONZE MEDAL**, Scouts earn the Environmental Science merit badge and at least three additional merit badges listed above in boldface, plus any two others. Then plan, lead, and carry out three significant projects from three separate categories listed.
- FOR THE HORNADAY SILVER MEDAL**, Scouts earn all the merit badges listed above in boldface, plus any three others. Then plan, lead, and carry out four significant projects in natural resource conservation or environmental improvements, one each from four of the eight project categories listed.

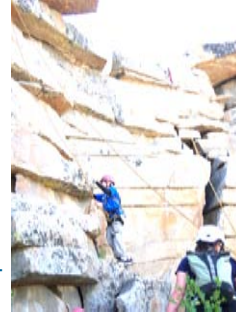
### Project Categories

The cost for this program is \$230 per scout. This includes food, lodging and all class materials. Adults are \$100. Class size is limited, so register early!

# Climbing/Ascent

This program is a week long backpacking program. There is room for 10 participants per trek out. Participants will spend the week in the backcountry of BDSR doing climbs that most people never see! Be prepared for a long strenuous week. Participants will need to provide all of their own backpacking equipment, as the week will be spent 100% in the backcountry with the exception of the first and last nights. All participants must be 13 by Jan. 1 and have previously earned the Climbing Merit Badge (no exceptions) and have the endurance for an extreme week of physical activity.



**Cost for this program is \$320.00 per scout and adult.**

# RAMS

This week will be filled with fun shooting experiences. All participants will have the opportunity to work on Rifle Merit Badge, Shotgun Merit Badge, and Archery Merit Badge. This week will be spent in classroom time and on the shooting ranges. All participants will be instructed in safety rules, use and storage of firearms and proper shooting techniques, ammunition reloading and will have the opportunity to advance in the NRA Marksmanship Qualification Program. This week is great for beginners and for experienced shooters wanting to learn and advance their shooting skills. Limit of 10 Scouts per unit. (Additional Scouts from the same unit can be put on the waitlist and added if the course is not full as of 6/15/10.)

**Cost for this program is \$320.00 per scout. Adults are \$100.**



# First Year Camper



This program is designed for your first year Scouts. The program is perfect for a patrol of first year Scouts. We will spend the week working on all the requirements up to First Class. Programs will include a 5-mile hike, two overnights, knot tying, first aid, cooking, citizenship, swimming, water rescue and much, much more. All additional cook-

ing and camping equipment will be provided for the Scouts. Staff will not sign off requirements in the Scouts' books, but will provide you with a list of all requirements that were worked on during their stay at camp. This is a great first time camping experience for you and your Scouts!

**Cost for this program is \$230.00 per Scout. Cost for an adult is \$100.**
