RETURN ON TIME DEPOSIT

The \$25 per canoe deposit is refunded to the unit if all equipment is returned to the Ben Delatour Scout Ranch in the same condition it was in when it was checked out, by the specified return date.

In the event of loss or damage of any kind whatever to the Equipment(canoes), troop shall, at troops option:

- (i) Place the same in good repair, condition and working order; or
- (ii) Replace the same with like equipment in good repair, condition and working order; or
- (iii) Pay to Longs Peak Council the replacement cost of the Equipment.

Insurance against loss of and damage to a third party caused while transporting the canoes is the responsibility of the troop.

Troops auto liability insurance will be primary insurance above all other insurance.

QUALIFIED SUPERVISION

SAFE SWIM DEFENSE

Qualified Supervision All swimming activity must be supervised by a mature and conscientious adult over 21 years of age who understands and knowingly accepts their responsibility for the well-being and safety of the children in their care, and who is experienced in the water and confident of their ability to respond in the event of an emergency, and who is trained in and committed to compliance with the eight points of BSA Safe Swim Defense. (It is strongly recommended that all Units have a least one adult or older youth member currently certified as a BSA Lifeguard to assist in the planning and conducting of all swimming activities.)

SAFETY AFLOAT

Qualified Supervision All activity afloat must be supervised by a mature and conscientious adult over 21 years of age, who understands and knowingly accepts their responsibility for the well-being and safety of the children in their care, and who is experienced and qualified in the particular watercraft skills and equipment involved in the activity and who is committed to compliance with the nine points of BSA Safety Afloat. One such supervisor is required for each 10 people, with a minimum of two adults for any one group. All supervisors must complete BSA Safety Afloat and Safe Swim Defense training and at least one must be certified in CPR. (It is strongly recommended that all Units have a least one adult or older youth member currently certified as a BSA Lifeguard to assist in the planning and conducting of all activity afloat.)

PADDLE CRAFT SAFETY

Paddle Craft Safety Training will be required for all units renting the Longs Peak Council Canoes. Trained Paddle Craft Safety personnel must be 16 years of age or older; have completed the BSA swimmers test: Jump feet first into water over the head in depth. Level off and swim 75 yards in a strong manner using one or more of the following strokes: sidestroke, breaststroke, trudgen, or crawl; then swim 25 yards using an easy resting backstroke. The 100 yards must be completed in one swim without stops and must include at least one sharp turn. After completing the swim, rest by floating; proof of Physical Fitness - health history record must be completed prior to arrival. Knowledge in basic canoeing skills.

For Cub Scouts Cub Scouts and Webelos Scouts may only use canoes as part of a Council activity or at a Council Camp under certified Council leadership. Cub Scout Packs may not rent the canoes!
