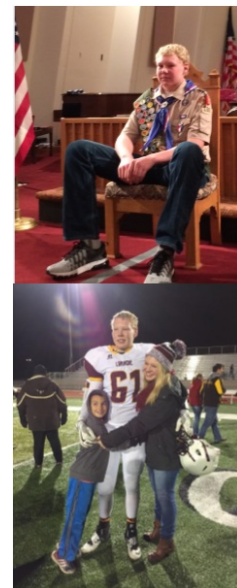

January's Eagle Scout of the Month

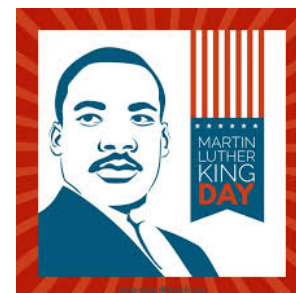
January's Eagle Scout of the Month is Frank C. from Troop 136 in Laramie, Wyoming. Frank started Scouting as a Tiger Cub Scout. Scouting has taught him to take personal responsibility and to be respectful to others. Frank's Eagle Scout project was to remove a 200 ft. brick wall which was 10 ft. high and 1 ft. wide for the First United Methodist Church in Laramie. The church is building a new sanctuary where the wall was located. Frank recruited over 20 people to help with the project and it took seven, ten hour days to complete. The original estimates for the church to tear down the wall was between \$50,000 and \$60,000. Frank was able to orchestrate the sale of the recycled material and in the end he was able to return \$400 to the church for their building fund. Frank says, "I learned how to manage a large project and how to work with adults. I learned how to make a budget, run a project and complete it on-time. Outside of Scouting Frank is involved in football, basketball, track and baseball. Through his leadership on and off the field he is also able to achieve a 4.0 grade point average in school. Frank's favorite Scouting activities have been attending the 2013 National Jamboree, 2014 Philmont Trek and in 2016 the Florida Sea Base. Frank is currently a junior at Laramie High School, he plans to attend college and hopes to play Division 1 football or basketball. Frank lives by the boy scout slogan, "Do a Good Turn Daily." 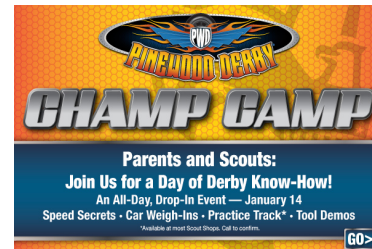
