## KEEP FOR YOUR REFERENCE

### Youth Staff Requirements and Expectations

- ✓ Parent or Guardian approval is required.
- ✓ Unit Leader's approval is required.
- ✓ Youth staff must be at least 14 years of age, but not yet 18 (Boy Scout), or 21 (Venturer), at course start date.
- ✓ Although not an absolute requirement, youth staff members should be at least Star rank at the course start date, and will be preferred during staff selection.
- ✓ Staff members will live by the Scout Oath and Scout Law and present themselves as role models for the participants at all times. This includes wearing a complete Scout or Venturing uniform, and wearing it correctly.
- ✓ Staff members must complete Youth Protection Training (General), Youth Protection Training for Venturing, and The Trainer's EDGE prior to the course start date. (Youth Protection Training is available online.)
- ✓ Staff members will attend all meetings associated with this training. Scheduled Staff Development meetings (all in 2018) are scheduled for **February, March, April, and May, 2018. Dates and locations will be announced ASAP**; the Parent & Participant Orientation in May, 2018.
- ✓ The **National Youth Leadership Training** is June 3–9, 2017, at the Jack Nicol Cub Scout Camp, Ben Delatour Scout Ranch, Red Feather Lakes, CO.
- ✓ Depending upon your staff position, you will also be required to **arrive one to two days** before the course start date to assist with setting up the course site.
- ✓ Proper advanced preparation is expected for all assignments.
- ✓ **Youth Staff Fee is \$100.** Fee must be paid in full at least 30 days prior to course start date. Staff fees cover the cost of meals, staff activity uniforms, patches, and staff recognition. Limited scholarships are available.
- ✓ **Interviews of staff applicants may be conducted prior to selection.** If so, you will be contacted by phone or e-mail to schedule an appointment.
- ✓ Staff selection is subject to the approval of the NYLT Scoutmaster and the Longs Peak Council.
