Note: Funds available for camperships covered by this application come from funds restricted for the use of Scouts registered in Longs Peak Council whose troop is registered to attend Summer Camp at Camp Jeffrey, Camp Laramie Peak, Elkhorn High Adventure Base and Jack Nicol Cub Scout Camp. The Council Camping Committee is concerned about the individual needs and the unit's individual evaluation of the Scout for whom this request is made.

Generally, camperships are limited to no more than 50% of the camp cost. Each Scout, his family, or his unit (or any combination) should provide a minimum of 50% of the camp cost.

Camperships are not transferable, refundable and have no cash value.

All information in the application will be treated confidentially.

Please list the amount requested including costs provided by the family, unit and chartered partner.

The ninth part of the Scout Law is "A Scout is THRIFTY". A Scout works to pay his own way. The Council Camping Committee is very interested in what the Scouts has done to assist his family in providing him with this camping experience. This is a character building opportunity for the Scout to learn the importance of being THRIFTY.

Unit Endorsement
